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History
Subject Code: 1021

CO 1. To study History of India from earliest time to 1205 AD. In this paper students will study Harappan Civilisation , Vedic Age, Mauryan and Post Mauryan Period and Arabs and Turks invasion in India. Students will also get insight of Arts and Architecture in ancient India.

CO 2. To study History of Indian from 1206 AD to 1525 AD. In this paper the students will get knowledge about Qutbuddin Aibak to Sultanate Period. This paper also covers social status of women and religious movements in India.

CO 3. To study History of India from 1206 AD to 1756 AD. In this paper the students will study about Medieval India and Mughal Empire to Maratha Empire. Students will also get knowledge about there administration, military systems, judicial system and religious policies.

CO 4. To study History from 1757 AD to 1947 AD. In this paper students will study about advent of European Powers in India (Portuguese, French and British). Revolt of 1857, socio-religious movements, education in India, Emergence of Mahatma Gandhi and his movements for freedom.


CO 5. To study History of Modern World from 1780 to 1920 AD. Students will study French Revolution, Italy and Germany, Russo-Japanese war, First World War, Russian Revolution. Paris Peace Conference and formation of The League of Nations.

CO 6. To study History of Modern World from 1921 to 1956 AD. In this paper students will study Rise of Fascism in Italy, Nazism in Germany and Stalin in Russia, Second World War. Formation of United Nation Organisation and Non-Aligned movement and the third World Origin and Progress

CO 7. To understand the basic themes, concepts and scope of World and Indian History.

CO 8. To study further in the field of History as Archaeology.

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Economics
Subject Code: 1022

CO 1. Micro Economics: - Students learn definition of micro economics, law of demand and supply. Study of cost and revenue analysis, market structure and production factors.

CO 2. Economy of Maharashtra: - Students learn Geographical and Economical features of Maharashtra, Demography of Maharashtra, Agriculture of Maharashtra. Study of Industry and Infrastructure in Maharashtra, Economy of Vidarbha Region.

CO 3. Macro Economics: - Students learn definition of Macro Economics. Study of Money and value of Money, Inflation and Deflation. Students also learn Output of Employment and International Trade.

CO 4. Banking System: - Students learn about Commercial Bank, Central Bank, Co-operative Bank. Study of International monetary fund and World Bank also recent services in banking sector.

CO 5. Indian Economy: - Students learn Basic features of Indian Economy, Importance of Agriculture in Indian Economy, Industrial Policies. Study of Indian foreign trade, poverty and unemployment's. Students also learn Environment and Pollution.

CO 6. Demography: - Students learn about Demography, Fertility and Mortality, Migration of Population. Students also study Urbanization of Population and Population and Human Development issues.

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Sociology

Subject code: 1024

CO 1. Introduction of Sociology: - Students learn meaning, nature and scope of Sociology. Study Sociology as Applied Science, learn Basic concepts of society, community, social groups, social structure, social institutions and social norms and values. Study of meaning of social control.

CO 2. Students learn Individuals and society WRT culture, family, marriage, religion, political systems and social movements. Students also Study social stratification and social changes.

CO 3. Social Problems in India: - Students learn meaning, nature and perspectives on social problems. Students also study Family problems, population problems and Alcoholism problems. Students also study problems related to rural community in India.

CO 4. Students get knowledge about current social problems such as Corruption, Terrorism, white collar Crimes, Problems of weaker section and Urbanization. Students also learn Intolerance, Riot and Crime related problems.

CO 5. Social Anthropology: - Students learn meaning and definition of social anthropology. Students also study Methods of social anthropology, Tribal Society in India, Tribal Religion and Tribal Economy.

CO 6. Students further gain knowledge about Tribal social life, Tribal family, Totemism, Tribal Problems and Developments.

CO 7. Students will be able to identify the interplay between race, class, gender, sexuality and other social groups.

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Political Science Subject Code: 1025
