Scholarships and Concessions

Students should apply separately in the prescribed form within the due dates to avail the facility. At present G.O.I. scholarship (for B.C. Candidates), Open Merit Scholarship, National Loan Scholarship, E.B.C. concession, primary/secondary Teacher concession, freedom Fighter concession, Eklavya scholarship, Scholarship for NSS/NCC, Grames students from Sant Gadage Baba Amravati University Kalyan Nidhi etc. are available for eligible students.

Note : It is necessary for Scholarship holder students to open their Saving Account in Central Bank of India Branch Kaulkhed, Akola on Zero Balance and inform their Bank Account Number to the college & fill up the scholarship form online before due date & submit the printout copy to the college alongwith the necessary documents. Link your aadhaar Number to your Bank Account.

Admission Procedure -

Admission is as per merit and other norms as laid down by University, the Government or the Management from time to time. Application for the admission must be made on prescribed form along with recent passport size photograph only. The student's application form must be filled in be the candidate in his/her own handwriting. Parent's/Father's/Mother's Signature is necessary at given space on the form. Students should write their detailed address and phone number on the admission form.

Admission will be provisiona, subject to the approval of the University / Board and is liable to be cancelled at any time if not approved by the University / Board or if the applicant has given false information.

Reservation of seats for candidates belonging to backward classes will be according to the government Regulations and Circulars.

All Matters related to admission will be handled by the admission committee. Applicants are required to contact this committee during working hours as displayed on the notice board.

- Rules & Regulations -

1. 75% attendance in each class & Subject is compulsory, otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear for University / Board examination.
2. Students should make careful use of college Books, furniture. Laboratory equipments and the college property in general. The cost of damages to it if any, would be recoverab le from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
